BOOKING CONDITIONS

1. BOOKING CONFIRMATION

- All bookings are made with SITCo Instructor Training Co. (The Company) whose registered address is The Ski & Snowboard Instructor Training Co., Po Box 791, Queenstown.
- No contract exists until the Company receives and acknowledges receipt of, the online application form and the relevant payment(s) (see below) in our bank account.
- The contract is subject to New Zealand law.

2. PAYMENT SCHEDULE INSTRUCTOR TRAINING COURSES

- A NZ\$200 non refundable payment is to be made when you register for a course. Confirmation of your registration will be sent by email.
- A NZ\$1800 payment non refundable deposit is to be made to secure your place. The sooner you secure your place the sooner the company can confirm your course.
- The final balance must be received by the company no later than 6 weeks prior to the course start date.
- All payments to be in New Zealand dollars.
- All payments must arrive into our bank account with the correct amount. Any transaction fees or bank fees, that are incurred, must be covered by you.

3. PAYMENT SCHEDULE PERFORMANCE SKI CAMPS

- A NZ\$200 non refundable payment will allow you to register for a camp. Confirmation of your registration will be sent by email.
- In order to confirm your place the final balance must be received by the company. Once full payment is received then confirmation of your place will be sent via email.
- All payments to be in New Zealand dollars.
- All payments must arrive into our bank account with the correct amount. Any transaction fees or bank fees, that are incurred, must be covered by you.

4. INSTRUCTOR TRAINING COURSE CANCELLATION BY COURSE DELEGATE

- Notification of cancellations must be made in writing as soon as possible by the person who filled out the application form.
- Cancellations made 6 weeks prior to the start of the course will be eligible for a full refund less the deposit. There will be no refunds after this date. There will be no refunds for any part of the course not undertaken or completed.

5. PERFORMANCE SKI CAMP CANCELLATION BY CAMP PARTICIPANT

- Notification of cancellations must be made in writing as soon as possible by the person who filled out the application form.
- Cancellations will be offered the possibility to reschedule. There will be no refunds for any part of the course not undertaken or completed.

6. CANCELLATION BY THE COMPANY

The Company reserves the right to cancel all courses and camps. In the unlikely event of this happening the moneys will be refunded in full. All refunds will be in NZ\$ and are regardless of exchange rate fluctuations.

7. SUBCONTRACTORS

Subcontractors may be used for product delivery during the course. All participants are subject to the rules and regulations of those subcontractors during the period they are being used.

8. TRAVEL, VISAS AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS

It is each participant's responsibility to organise their own work visa, and personal situation to ensure that they can enter and travel in NZ, to allow them to participate.

9. COVID RELATED TRAVEL DISRUPTIONS

All government, NZ and overseas, recommendations will be observed. For peace of mind, if participants who normally reside outside of New Zealand and are unable to travel to New Zealand, due to border closure mandated with either the respective countries or the New Zealand government, then affected guests are eligible for a full credit or refund on their purchased products.
